

Policy for Medications for Extracurricular Activities

- Students with Significant Health Conditions are required to self-carry their emergency medications (Epi-pen, Benadryl, Inhaler) for all after school activities. These activities include clubs, office hours, library, and sports. The health room is not accessible to staff and students after school hours.
- Students who self-carry their medications need to have the correct paperwork filled out and signed. The Medications Permission Form needs to be signed by both the parent and the physician. This form can be found on the Summit website in the Health Room tab under “Our School”. Please make sure the physician signs the bottom line, giving permission for your child to self-carry (for Epi-pens and inhalers). If your child plans to self-carry any medication besides an Epi-pen or an inhaler, please come to the office to sign a self-carry contract in addition to the Medications Permission Form.
